Overview

In the early stages of his career, Lawyer Hsu Yuan-Hao began as an intern at Root Law Firm, where he participated in litigation involving fuel costs between Taiwan Power Company, the Fair Trade Commission, and nine other private power plants, with a total amount at stake reaching NT\$6.2 billion.
